

# Changes in and around Littlehampton

Our current 700 service between Littlehampton and Worthing will be replaced by new routes 11 and 701. The new routes mean we'll be running more buses across Worthing & Littlehampton, especially in the evening and at the weekends! We'll also be adding more time to our timetables and avoiding level crossings to reduce the risk of running late. A new direct link on the 701 from Littlehampton to Worthing Hospital will also make it easier for those needing to access healthcare.

## 701 Wick • Littlehampton • Rustington • Goring • Worthing Hospital • Lancing

- Every 15 mins Mon-Sat daytime; every 20 mins on Sundays
- Faster bus from Littlehampton/Rustington to Goring/Worthing (no longer serves East Preston & runs fast along A259)
- Direct service to Worthing Hospital
- Change buses at Worthing Marine Parade for service 700 to/from Brighton

## 11 Littlehampton • Rustington • East Preston • Ferring • Goring • Worthing

- Every 30 mins Mon-Sat daytime; hourly on Sundays
- Runs Via Beaumont Park to Rustington Shops, then follows current 700 route to Worthing

9 500 There are no changes to 9 & 500

## Why are we making these changes?

We know buses get delayed waiting for trains at level crossings. This impacts everyone waiting for a bus to arrive at their stop, then being late for work or important appointments. The new routes will help keep buses on time, with fewer trips over level crossings at East Preston and Ferring.



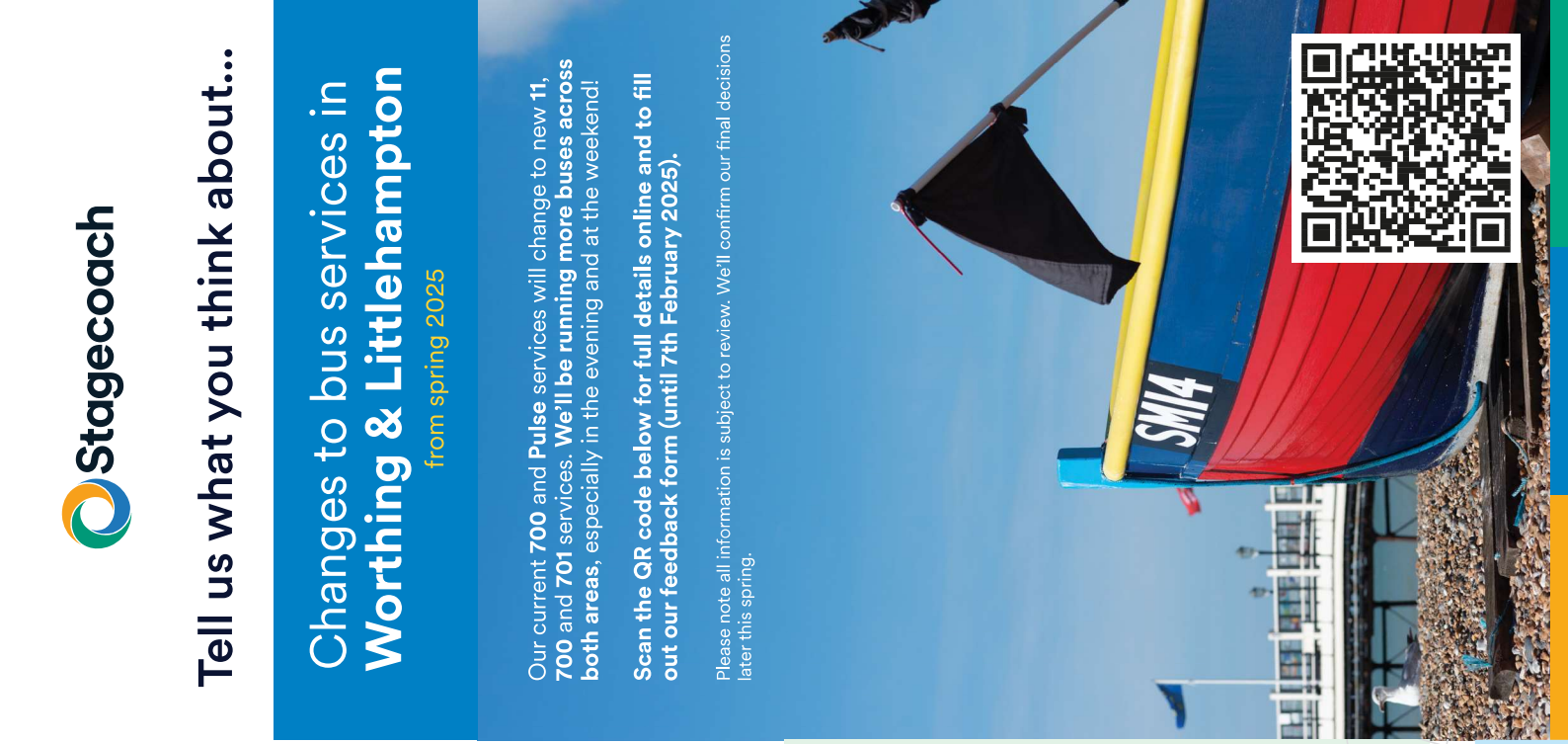

# Changes in and around Worthing

We'll be running more buses, especially in the evening and at the weekends! We know buses get delayed waiting for trains at level crossings. This impacts everyone waiting for a bus, who may then be late for work or important appointments. The new routes will help keep buses on time, with fewer trips over level crossings at East Preston and Ferring. These latest changes are designed to offer a better bus network and provide the right number of buses in the right place at the right time.

## 5

**Why has it changed?** We'll run more frequently as our current buses are very busy. Buses will stop being affected by delays on the 10 at West Worthing level crossing.

- **Every 20 mins Mon-Sat; every 30 mins on Sundays**
- New route with stops on Celadine Road & Cornfield Way
- **Later evening buses!** Last buses from Worthing after 2500 Mon-Sat and 2100 on Sundays
- No longer running along Carisbrooke Drive, but buses will still call at stops on Romany Road

## 10

**New hourly Sunday service** (no other Mon-Sat changes)

- Improved punctuality

## 11

**Littlehampton • Rustington • East Preston • Goring • Worthing**

- **Every 30 mins Mon-Sat; hourly on Sundays**
- Follows current 700 route through Ferring, Goring and Worthing

## 1 7 9

There are no changes to routes 1, 7 & 9. The Pulse will be replaced by new routes 700 and 701.

## 700

**Durrington • Worthing • Shoreham • Brighton**

**Why has it changed?** Buses are easily delayed on longer routes, so we're making the route shorter and avoiding level crossings.

- **Every 12 mins Mon-Sat daytime; every 15 mins on Sundays**
- **More buses** between West Durrington & Worthing
- **Direct service** from West Durrington to Shoreham/Brighton

## 701

**Wick • Littlehampton • Rustington • Goring • Worthing • Worthing Hospital • Lancing**

- **Every 15 mins Mon-Sat daytime; every 20 mins on Sundays**
- **Faster bus** from Worthing/Goring to Littlehampton/Rustington
- **More Sunday buses** in the early morning and evening
- Continues to Lancing following the current Pulse route

## Where can I change buses?

Customers travelling between routes 5 and 10 should change at **Durrington Tesco**. Customers travelling between Littlehampton & Worthing to/from Shoreham & Brighton will need to change at **Worthing Marine Parade**.
