

PUBLIC NOTICE

Temporary closure of Goring Way South, Goring, 19th January 2026.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that from the date specified below, West Sussex County Council has temporarily closed to all traffic, Goring Way South, Goring, in the Worthing District (B) under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, on Goring Way South outside no. 34 Goring Way.

The temporary closure is scheduled to commence on 19th January 2026 for up to 5 days (it is estimated to be completed on 23rd January 2026) and is required for the safety of the public and workforce while BT undertakes 24 hour a day road closure to allow for spine cable work. Road closed from outside no. 34 Goring Way to the Compton Avenue junction.

The restriction will be in place **24hrs only** from 08:00 until 17:00

Access maintained for emergency services, residents and pedestrians.
