6	<b>Committee Remit</b> Councillor Stephen Abbott has kindly revised the Committee Remit and a copy has been sent to all Councillors. The revised remit will be recommended to Full Council.	FC
7	<ul> <li>Allotment Land</li> <li>It was acknowledged that there are two plots of land that may be suitable for allotments both of which are owned by Persimmon. Persimmon has advised that they will not enter into any negotiation until after the local plan has passed examination and is adopted.</li> <li>Councillor Carole Robertson advised that with regards to the two pieces of land behind the Henty Public House, within the CRTBO's, the proposed development has been designed in such a way that it is possible to only develop one of the pieces of land and keep the other as allotments should this be necessary.</li> <li>It was acknowledged that the access to the above mentioned pieces of land is owned by the Parish Council and has foot access only. It does not have vehicular access.</li> </ul>	
8	<ul> <li>Land Valuation         <ul> <li>Councillor Carole Robertson advised that further to the meeting with WSCC on 6<sup>th</sup> September, FPC has met with a couple of local companies that can provide valuations for Village Hall site, parish office and Allotment and private land as WSCC requested. Once received, the quotations will be agreed by Council and how the valuation costs will be met will be discussed and agreed with the Village Hall Committee.</li> <li>It was agreed that when submitting the valuations to WSCC, it will be asked that they provide FPC with their valuation of the Glebelands.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	
9	<ul> <li>Purchase of the Glebelands</li> <li>WSCC, in principle, agree that they are happy to sell the freehold to FPC. However, there will be restrictions, covenants and clauses attached to the purchase agreement with expected proposal of a right to buy with a three year window.</li> <li>It was acknowledged that the Village Hall site and the Community Centre were not scheduled to start until at least year 8-9 of the Neighbourhood Plan therefore the proposed three years window is in keeping with the projects projected timescale.</li> <li>A further meeting with WSCC will be arranged for early November.</li> </ul>	

	<ul> <li>Village Hall Representative Betty McCann suggested that this was a good time to organise a Steering Group Meeting to discuss fund raising options and methods to invite residents and other organisations to get involved in the project.</li> <li>Councillor Roger Elkins suggested that there should be an agreement between involved bodies including the Village Hall &amp; Glebelands.</li> <li>Councillor Roger Elkins suggested that as FPC is now in discussions with WSCC, key financial information should be discussed and considered.</li> </ul>	
10	<ul> <li>Review of the Project Plan</li> <li>It was advised that Councillor Terry Jackson has updated the Top Level Progress for the NP. This will be circulated to the committee members.</li> </ul>	PC
