1	Apologies for Absence Apologies were received from Councillors Chris Headon	
2	Declarations of Interest Councillor Carole Robertson declared an interest in planning application FG/178/16/HH.	

3	Public Question Time  A resident asked in relation to planning application FG/171/16/PL raising concerns that the application describes the land as vacant land and asked if the application should be labelled with correct information. It was acknowledged that the proposed vacant land is part of the applicant's garden. The same resident also raised the concern that the proposed development is very close to its and the neighbours boundaries.  A further resident mentioned that the NPPF encourages the development of brown field sites; he asked if planning application FG/171/16/PL site is a brown field site. Councillor Carole Robertson advised the resident that all applications will be considered on their own merit and this would be considered as a windfall site.  The same resident advised that the 'log store' shown on the plans was his garden and asked in relation to access to the potential development and the consideration given to pedestrians. Councillor Peter Evans advised that this would be a matter for WSCC Highways, however as this is a private road it is possible that WSCC will make no comment. The same resident also raised the concern of the size of the proposed development and the lack of proposed parking with the application only offering one parking space which is shown as the garage.
