What is Good Neighbours?

Good Neighbours provides support to older people who are living alone and socially isolated. We aim to increase independence and social contact, reduce feelings of loneliness and help people to re-engage with their local community.

Who is Good Neighbours for?

This service is open to individuals over the age of 55 who would benefit from short-term support for up to 12 weeks.

How much will it cost?

Good Neighbours is funded by West Sussex County Council and is available free of charge. However, you will need to meet any associated expenses such as phone calls and activity charges where applicable.
