

Beach Litter

Following concerns raised by residents, over litter and overflowing bins on Patterson's Walk, the Environment, Amenities and Footpaths Committee of FPC arranged an onsite meeting with Arun District Council to explore potential solutions.



As a result, we are pleased to confirm that we now have additional black bins along the beach front between the Bluebird Café to the end of Patterson's Walk, generally adjacent to the Dog Waste bins.

There is new signage in the car park requesting visitors take their litter home and there will be further signs along Patterson's Walk outlining where the nearest dog waste/litter bins can be found.

We have a commitment from ADC that BIFFA will provide additional checks and emptying to meet the demand in the summer months.

We appreciate the ongoing support and commitment of ADC in working with us to keep our beach front tidy.
