



PUBLIC NOTICE

Temporary closure of Ferring Street, Ferring CP, 28th June 2022

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that from the date specified below, West Sussex County Council has temporarily closed to all traffic Ferring Street, Ferring CP, in the Arun District under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, on Ferring Street for a distance approx 21 metres

The temporary closure is scheduled to commence on 28th June 2022 for up to 5 days (It is estimated to be completed on 29th June 2022) and is required for the safety of the public and workforce while Network Rail Infrastructure Ltd undertakes Overnight Road Closure to undertake line painting and level crossing maintenance. Closed between junction with Langbury Lane to junction with Onslow Drive with works taking place at Ferring Level Crossing

The restriction will be in place **overnight only** from 23:59 until 05:00

Access for emergency service vehicles and pedestrians will be maintained at all times during the closure.
