13	Environment Liaison Committee  a. Hanging Baskets – The Committee considered the quotation for proposed hanging baskets. Councillor Andy Walker outlined a full costing to erect hanging baskets at 8 lamp posts in Ferring Street from the village sign up to the railway line.  One off cost £2568.00 + vat for lampposts structure testing and installation of the baskets and annual costs seasonal planting and maintenance costs - £1686.00 + vat.

	accessing the site via Arun District Council.  The committee noted the difference in pricing between the two quotations and agreed to proceed with the preferred contractor.

The Committee noted that the grant application states that the organisation is in the process of leasing the Pump House and are waiting for the lease to be produced by Arun Distrct Council (ADC). The grant application is for funding in the short term to go through the legal details of the lease and to apply for planning permission to extend the shed. The cost will involve employing a solicitor to review the lease, application fees for planning permission and associated costs.
